

Eurostars guidelines for obtaining a PIC number.

This document aims to help the applicants find their PIC number, which is requested in the Eurostars registration form.¹

What is a PIC number

The Participation Identification Code (PIC) is a 9-digit unique identification number attributed by the European Commission to organisations participating in a call for proposals with eSubmission².

All organisations participating in Eurostars-3 projects are required to provide their PIC number in their registration form. Therefore, all partner organisations of a consortium must have an individual PIC number.

Please note: The PIC number is a mandatory field of the registration form. Without a PIC number, you will not be able to complete the registration and therefore start, join or submit a Eurostars application. Please allow sufficient time to obtain a PIC number for your organisation before registering and submitting the application form. In case of a technical problem, it might require several days to obtain your PIC number. As the PIC webpage is not run by the Eureka Secretariat, we will not be able to help you nor accept your application in case of delays beyond the submission deadline.

To obtain a PIC number, you must submit a request through the European Commission's Funding and Tenders Portal. The portal provides a dedicated webpage with detailed information on how to obtain a PIC number, which you can access at:

To retrieve your PIC number

To check whether your organisation has already been registered for a PIC number, you can search for it directly in the Funding and Tenders Portal of the European Commission.

• Click on "Find a registered organisation".



- Search for your organisation using the name of organisation and/or VAT number. Additionally, you can use the different filters to find your organisation.
- If you cannot find it, please follow the steps of the next session.

To register for a new PIC number

If you do not have a PIC number, you can register for one by following these steps:

If you want to participate in a call for proposals or in a call for tenders with eSubmission, your organisation needs to be registered and have a 9-digit Participant Identification Code (PIC). Please quote your PIC in all correspondence with the Commission.
The register contains all participants of EU programmes.

Please check whether your organisation has already been registered. If so, no need to register it again.

Register your organisation
To register your organisation or as a natural person, you need to login into the Portal or, if you are a new user, create your account.
Check what information you need to register in the Online Manual - and keep it to hand during the registration procedure. To start registration, click on the button below.
S Register your organisation
You can suspend the registration process at any time: the data entered can be saved as draft and you can continue your registration later. To return to your registration, please log in and get into My Organisation(s) in the My Area section. Incomplete, draft r
Additionally, for actions where the SME status is an eligibility criterion (like, e.g. the EIC Accelerator) you must also carry out the SME self-assessment.
Should your project or tender be successfully evaluated, the registered data will be verified by the Central Validation Service team before the signature of the Grant Agreement or of the Framework Contract.

• Sign in if you already have an account or if you are using a European eID. If you do not have an account, select "Create an account" and complete the process.
